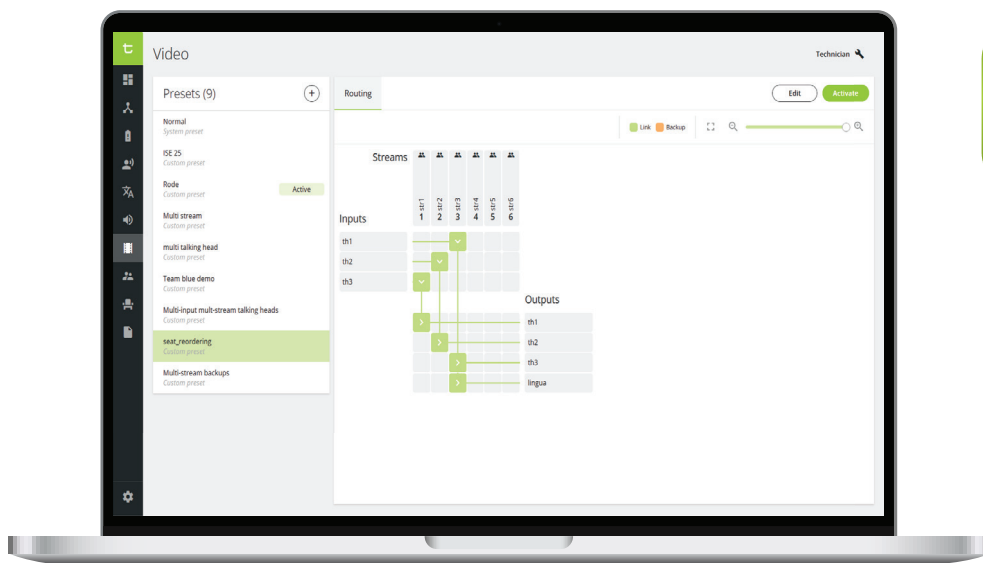

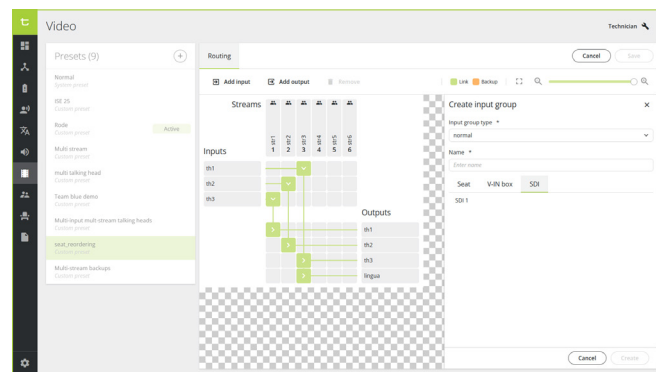
Extended Video Possibilities

- » Assign video input devices to a video request group effortlessly.
- » Assign webcam units to a talking head group.
- » Assign video input devices on a specific video stream.
- » Create video output groups consisting of video output boxes or Lingua ID-MM units.
- » Assign a unique label to each video stream for easy identification.
- » Visualize inputs or input groups and assign them to specific video streams.
- » Configure available video streams for video channel selectors.
- » Assign specific video streams to a video output devices or video output groups.

All video settings are defined as part of a video configuration. These configurations can be created and edited directly in your web browser, with every configuration securely stored on the Plexus engine.

Consequently, the Confero Advanced Video license allows you to create a set of video routing input and output groups, visualized with an intuitive and easily editable matrix that reflects your advanced settings.

User Roles
